SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

PURPOSE:

To provide a student with the assistance in offsetting costs to attend a college or university of their choice. These awards shall be administered through the Scholarship Committee awarded to sons/daughters of active members in good standing of the San Antonio Hispanic Police Officers Organization (SAHPOO). Members must have been a member of SAHPOO for at least two years or upon graduation from the Police Academy. A limited number of awards may be awarded to qualifying students in the San Antonio, Bexar County and surrounding areas.

ELIGIBILITY:

Funds are to be awarded on the basis of:

- 1 **Academics** – Each applicant must be a high school senior student. Applicants must meet the requirements for entrance in the Community College/University of his or her choice. Applicants must have maintained a 3.3 G.P.A. or better. Others will be considered under special circumstances.
- 2 **Citizenship** – Each applicant must show evidence of moral force of character, unselfishness, and consideration of others.
- 3 **Leadership** – Each applicant must demonstrate leadership in the home, at school, and community activities.

DEFINITIONS:

- 1 “B+” Average – a school level of work that is no less than 3.3 at the high school level.
- 2 Scholarships – those funds awarded as a result of need and desire on the applicant’s part.
- 3 Senior – a student in his last year of high school.
- 4 Special Circumstance Applicant – applicants that have obtained a G.E.D. or who’s grades are below 3.3 GPA.

DEADLINE:

Applicants shall mail a completed application for scholarship to the Scholarship Committee. Applications **must** be postmarked no later than **Wednesday March 10th, 2021**. *Applications will only be accepted through this method* (no hand deliveries). **Mail to:**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST ACCOMPANY A COMPLETED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED:

- 1 A copy of applicant’s ACT and SAT scores. (Not needed for Community College)
- 2 An official transcript of applicant’s grades (applicants should include the first semester of his or her senior year transcript), conduct marks, courses taken, or G.E.D. certificate.
- 3 A 500 to no more than 550 word essay. The essay **MUST** be double spaced, 12 inch font, New Times Roman, and typed. (No hand written essays will be accepted). The essay will be about, **“Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development. Explain how it helped you choose your future career.”**
- 4 Two letters of reference. (Non-relative).

All questions must be answered for application to be complete.
